 Introduction of the Course: Social research helps the students to acquire knowledge of human society. Social research enables us to analyse social behaviours, understand the course and accelerate its evaluation. 2) Objectives: The course is an introductory course on how research is actually done. With emphasise on formulating research design methods of data collection and data analysis, it will provide students with some elementary knowledge on how to conduct both, qualitative and

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### REPORT ON ADD-ON COURSE

Department of Sociology conducted an Add-On Course on "Gender and Law" from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023 to 13<sup>th</sup> February 2023. The course was based on both theoretical and practical surveys on awareness regarding legal protection, social issues and the protection of women.
